



#### Housing starts in the most important markets














- 5 buildings with 9 floors each
- 6.500 m3 CLT





- Italy's highest building made of CLT
- 4 building with 9 floors each
- 124 apartments (50-100 m2)
- 6.000 m3 CLT





- 6 floors
- in the district Barangaroo, located directly on the harbor
- · area of 22 hect.
- 2.000 m3 CLT
- 1.000 m3 Laminas






- 75% energy autarkic
- Winner of the "Finnish Wood Award" 2013
- Prize for sustainability of European museums 2015
- 870 m3 CLT


